Healthcare Staffing Crisis Leads to Internal Training Needs

- More than 70% of employers have or are planning on creating new hire or reskilling training programs.
- 82% of employees believe a career laddering program for entry-level workers would increase employee retention rates, however, only 45% currently offer a program.
