

## What is changing with Anatomy & Physiology?

New enhancements will be added to the Anatomy & Physiology products as of September 25, 2024, and will impact any new courses started after this date.

You'll now have access to new features including:

- **Interactive Tour** to familiarize you with how to use the product, located under "Help"
- **Annotation Tools** including bookmarking, highlighting, and note taking capabilities
- **Progress completion bar** in the main menu will show how far a learner has progressed through a particular lesson
- **Interactive BioDigital Learning Models** - embedded throughout modules to provide an interactive learning resource with an added 3D visual component to reinforce learning.

## Does this change impact the End of Module quizzes or reporting capabilities?

No, this format change does not impact the End of Module Quizzes or any reports.

## Does this update include any changes to the content within either of these products?

There are no changes to the content itself within the Anatomy & Physiology product. Only the format in which the content is presented will be updated.

## Why is the experience changing for the Anatomy & Physiology?

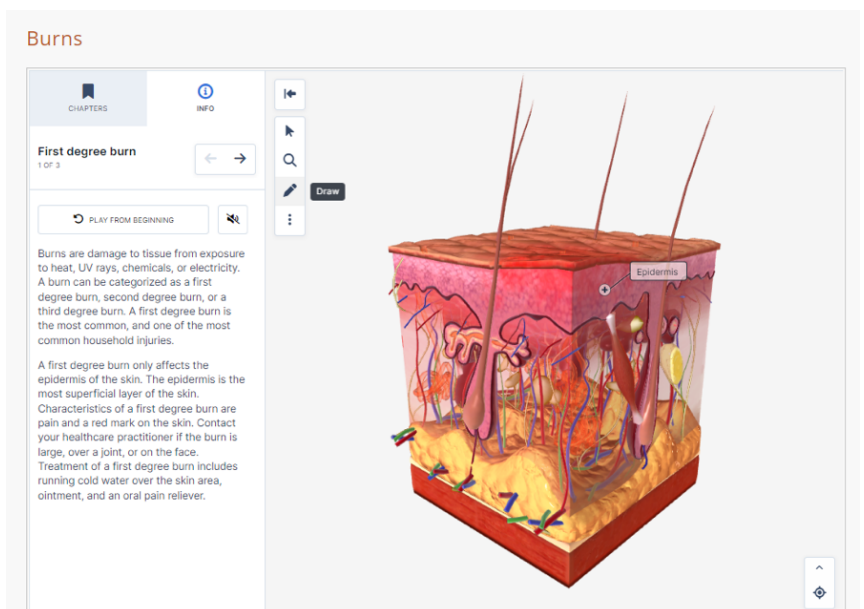
This change will provide a cohesive learning experience across the NHA product line.

## How do I use the new BioDigital Interactive Learning Models?

Each BioDigital 3D learning model can be manipulated by using either a mouse, keyboard, or touchscreen. Each model also offers a Help feature where learners may access the Getting Started Video, 3D Navigation Tutorial, and Keyboard shortcuts. It is recommended that the learner enter full screen mode to get the most benefit from the learning model. For reference, both the Help and full screen mode are indicated in the image below.

**What do I need to do after September 25 when these enhanced products launch?**

You don't have to do anything, but as an instructor/facilitator please be aware of the following:

- Any course that has already been started with an active learner in the course will have no impact. Learners will continue to use the product they were enrolled in and will see the BioDigital learning models in the version they are actively using.
- NHA will automatically move any existing unused or unassigned inventory over to the new product version on September 25, 2024.
- Instructors/facilitators can add new learners to an existing course (assuming inventory is available) up until inventory is automatically moved to the enhanced product.
- Beginning September 25, any new courses created should use the new enhanced version of the product.
- Prior to October 23, if you are enrolling learners into a new course, please connect with your NHA representative first to ensure your inventory can be moved to the new experience.

**What will happen to my existing inventory?**

When the new version of the product becomes available on September 25, inventory will stay as is until October 23. On October 23, all unassigned or unused inventory will automatically be moved over to the new versions of the product. No action is needed on your part.

**What are the names of the current products and the new enhanced products?**

On September 25<sup>th</sup> the current product "Anatomy & Physiology" will no longer be available to add to new courses.

**What happens to my existing courses where I have learners actively using the products?**

- Learners that are enrolled in a course will experience no impact and can continue using the current product with the addition of BioDigital models.
- Until inventory is transitioned (October 23), institutions can add learners to an existing course provided inventory is available.
- When possible, new learners should be put into a new course created with the updated materials. Please first contact your NHA Representative so your inventory can be moved to the new experience prior to October 23.

**When I create a new course, which version of the product should I select?**

Beginning September 25, only the new versions of the product will be available when you create a new course. Any unused/unassigned inventory will be moved to the new product September 25<sup>th</sup> and will be reflected in your inventory. If you require your inventory to be migrated sooner, simply contact your NHA representative for assistance.
